Non-Deletion and Transition Clause

The language below may act as a template to be brought before a state's Central Committee to be passed into the State Party's bylaws to ensure a smooth transition process.

Proposed New or Revised Content

The South Dakota Republican Party will be transparent and open with the incoming administration regarding all data possessed by the previous administration. All data, whether paper documentation or digital documentation house in Customer Report Management (CRM) system shall not be deleted and promptly and properly transferred over to the incoming administration with in 36 hours of the new administration's election.
