D. Resignations

Upon receipt of any resignation via text, email, voice or written form is effective immediately and the officer will be removed from any executive board communication, financial accounts, social media, website, secretary of state filings and other board related items. A resigned elected official cannot be used to establish or count toward a quorum. Once a resignation takes effect, the office becomes vacant immediately without pending acceptance.
